We are sad for his parting but happy to see how the Bible School Ministry has grown and flourished through these years. The work of the Bible School, in preparing young native preachers and gospel workers continues growing and reaching out under the leadership of Pablo Ledezma, Luis Rodríguez, David's son, and other capable teachers. We have set up a new fund to assist these teachers who travel from their own churches to come and teach in the Bible School. The other great missionary worker that we have lost is James Betscher who in recent years has been heading up the work of the Children's Home in Monterrey. Many of you are familiar with our beautiful Children's Home having visited at some time in the past. When Cathy and I left living in Monterrey and came to the Mission Texas area we left the Children's Home to our son Wyman Leroy. After a few years he left it to Brother Jim Betscher and his wife Betty. Jim came to us through a missionary group who frequently visited our Children's Home and have been a great blessing. Jim came often with that group and really fell in love with the children and that ministry. In time we saw that God had sent brother Jim, just as he had sent us years earlier, to work in that ministry. He and Betty had the calling and passion for it and are doing an excellent job. Although we have not said much about Jim and Betty we have deeply appreciated their dedication to this ministry. It is with sadness that we report that Jim passed away also this month on March 14 and went to be with the Lord. Again in this case the ministry will continue under the capable leadership of his wife Betty and her capable staff. Our son Wyman continues to oversee the Children's Home.

On a very hot Texas afternoon on Thursday, August 25th we took our short journey across the Rio Grande into the City of Reynosa, Mexico. Brother Wyman drove, with Cathy and me to meet with Pastor Ada at the Templo Vida Abundante, Pentecostes. Though the needs are great, the Lord was with us to supply much needed school supplies to the children residing there. What a blessing we shared in the love of Christ with our brothers and sisters in Reynosa.



Reynosa, a City founded in 1749 has grown to a 2013 census to 672,183. It is the 3rd largest U.S./Mexico Border area with a population of 1.5 million. The City is located in the State of Tamaulipas, and is the 28th largest City in Mexico.

Driving into the City we could see the desperate condition of the people with the rough roads, unfinished buildings and homes and overgrowth of vegetation; then right in the middle of it all we found the church, like an oasis of hope in the middle of poverty and blight.

Upon arrival we were greeted by Pastora Ada, and soon to follow, despite the heat and being a Thursday afternoon, were the families with approximately 25 smiling children. We enjoyed the picture taking, refreshments and then a bit of fellowship. By God's grace, as Brother Wyman interpreted, I spoke an encouraging word to the children and was able to pray for each one individually. Their smiling faces and joy were evidence of the Presence of the Lord working in their lives, as they committed their young hearts to Jesus.
