WYMAN AND CATHY PYLANT STILL MINISTERING TO ORPHAN CHILDREN IN MEXICO 1966-2015



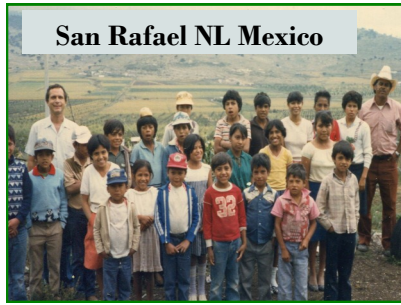
In 1966 God called Cathy and me to Mexico to do missionary work. We understood that to mean; preach the gospel to the unsaved of that land, and related activities. But soon after arriving and taking up residence there the Lord began to lead us in other somewhat unusual ways. Our leaders asked us one day "would you be willing to start an orphanage" "What"? "That was not part of our vision, nor our training." "But we don't know anything about that kind of work". "But we came for another purpose." "But we..." After exhausting our list of objections and concerns, we agreed to give it some thought and prayer. It was divine guidance. We began to ask officials, pastors, social workers and before long we were taking in children. Children who were suffering loneliness, fear, abandonment, abuse. We saw the need. We began to feel the hurt of children, it was like the Spirit of God spoke clearly to us. I want you to found that Children's Home.

From that beginning we have been laboring 49 years to give a loving, secure, home and family to hundreds of needy, hurting children, not only in Monterrey Mexico where we started, but in Nicaragua, Guatemala, and other countries where this call-

ing and passion have taken us. We continue doing this labor of love and compassion even today, in 2015, with God's help and strength. Below is a list of Children's Homes we have founded or helped to establish:
